We sat down with roughly 20 of WEIU's biggest fans and recorded spots highlighting our purpose and need for sustaining membership support. Producer Rameen Karbassioon had great success with airing his "Bob Spoo's Legacy at EIU" Documentary. It was even playing as new EIU Head Football Coach Chris Wilkerson was being announced to the campus community. WEIU Productions helped facilitate live streams of Sarah Bush Lincoln's Holiday Auction as well as EIU's Fall Commencements. Our station hosted a live, 12-hour Giving Tuesday Marathon to push for viewer support and showcase how we serve the community. City Spotlight continues production on Season 8, with many wonderful, returning locations featured. And, after time spent taping last fall and editing over the winter, WEIU is now airing its newest outdoor show Take a Hike: The Mini-Series featuring episodes at Lake Charleston, Lake Shelbyville, Lincoln Trail State
