Wanda Kay Robinson and Lacey Spence are working on this program with 15 storytellers. Teutopolis: This Is Our Story is set for recording next week and an airdate of June 17th. Let's Learn is a new educational program that airs weekdays at 4:00pm and has been shared throughout the region. About 6 different teachers have recorded spots to air around this program to share their perspective on education and this past year.
