Also, a live one-hour edition of Being Well aired featuring Coronavirus and Mental Health.

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In February 2020, WEIU launched the 13th program in the "Our Story" series, "Sullivan: This is Our Story". This program gets community members involved in telling the story of their local community as well as doing the videotaping, taking photos and gathering history. But, due to the social distancing requirements of COVID-19, the program



has delayed. Once protocols were put in place and it was a safer environment to interview storytellers, the production took place several months later in July 2020.

Sullivan: This is Our Story – WEIU's 13th production in the Our Story Series, featuring 17 stories on Sullivan, Illinois. The live airing of this program aired on October 29th, and was two hours in length.



Charleston was named a Monarch Champion by the National Wildlife Federation, and the video is featured on the NWF's webpage and social media outlets.
