


"NEW" Local Series coming in 2022

Production took place in Fall of 2021, and Take a Hike: The Mini-Series is slated to start airing Monday's at 8 p.m. in April of 2022.

This show will feature six locations: Lake Charleston, Lake Shelbyville, Lincoln Trail State Park, Douglas Hart Nature Center, Allerton Park, and Forest Glen Preserve.

The program featured moments, and interviews with family, colleagues, and former players and assistant coaches, on the 25 years of Bob Spoo at EIU.


Bob Spoo's Legacy at EIU – 90 minutes





During the school year, WEIU-TV airs an educational program titled *Let's Learn*. This program broadcasts over the air and streams weekdays between 4-5 p.m. to support young learners after regular school hours.

WEIU-TV partnered with schools and educators in our broadcast viewing area to record 30-second promotional support spots to air around this new program.



We plan to produce longer interstitials with local educators and some students to highlight the unique teaching and learning occurring in our broadcast viewing area. These interstitials will also air around *Let's Learn* as well as during PBS Kids daytime programming and in some prime time slots.



WEIU TV staff hosted a LIVE on-air fundraising event on Giving Tuesday - Tuesday, November 30th from 8:00am – 8:00pm. This was a special event promoting WEIU Passport to gain more streaming viewers/members. We broadcast live on air and streaming on our website and Facebook for 12 hours at the top and bottom of each hour. We also went completely LIVE for an entire hour at 7:00pm and then followed with a LIVE 30-minute preview of a new local production "Take A Hike". The total amount raised for this Giving Tuesday was \$6117.05
