


- *I am a devoted Saturday morning watcher on Dish. I also enjoy the other sewing shows. Rebecca B.






New Social Media Engagement Opportunities

WEIU-TV is working to be #trending. WEIU is officially on the social media platform TikTok and Instagram. The station is in its beginning stages of breaking into both of these this social media spaces. Content production is expected to increase in the coming months as staff become more familiar with this technology. WEIU TV broadcasts FNX on a second digital channel 51.2

FNX|First Nations Experience is the first and only broadcast television network in the U.S. dedicated 24/7 to Native American and World Indigenous Programming.

Outside of the Chicago area, WEIU TV is the only PBS affiliate station broadcasting this channel for viewers in Illinois.

WEIU-TV is licensed to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University.
Our 174-kilowatt digital signal on Channel 51.1 is broadcast from our 502-foot tower located southeast of Humboldt, IL.
