City Spotlight, produced and hosted by Rameen Karbassioon, concluded Season 9 and has started Season 10. City Spotlight covers communities in Central and Southeastern Illinois. The number of communities covered on City Spotlight thru the start of Season 10, is now at 24. In 2023, first time episodes were done on the communities of Robinson and Villa Grove. In episodes produced during calendar year 2023, education, festivals, and many new things to our local communities were the focus.

Also, a couple of episodes were produced at the end of Season 9, focusing on individuals. One of those episodes on an individual, was about a limb-different child, who excels in athletics in his community of Neoga, Illinois. The feature on Jack Finney of Neoga, was a two-part feature dubbed, "City Spotlight - Person Spotlight - Jack Finney". The entire feature on Jack Finney, just over an hour in length, aired online only, on the WEIU Youtube and Facebook pages.

City Spotlight is almost recorded exclusively on-location in the communities that are being featured.

In the 11 new episodes produced, in-studio and on-location tapings were conducted, with a Paw Report record, six on-location tapings. Subject matter covered included behavior-related issues of cats and dogs, new treatments for animals with cancer, a visit to a reindeer ranch, a trip to a bloodhound service, and our second trip to Indiana, as we checked out the Indiana Skunk Rescue.

These programs get community members involved in telling the story of their local community as well as doing some of the video recording, taking photos and gathering history.





WEIU TV broadcasts FNX on a second digital channel 51.2

FNX|First Nations Experience is the first and only broadcast television network in the U.S. dedicated 24/7 to Native American and World Indigenous Programming.

Outside of the Chicago area, WEIU TV is the only PBS affiliate station broadcasting this channel for viewers in Illinois.

WEIU TV broadcasts a 24/7 Weather Radar on a third digital channel 51.6

with Hit-Mix 88.9 WEIU FM radio as background music.

WEIU offers station tours to the community, student organizations, schools, clubs, and prospective students.

In 2023, WEIU gave 23 station tours to approx. 500 individuals



WEIU also participated in (4) Eastern Illinois University Open House activities where over 1120 pre-registered guests attended. WEIU staff and students spoke to prospective students about educational hands-on opportunities available at the station to enhance their learning experience.

Educational Services



During the summer of 2023, student volunteer Brayden Armstrong packaged Summer Reading Program materials and delivered them to 18 libraries in the WEIU TV broadcast viewing area. 207 packets were created with Summer Reading Logs, Work It Our Wombats, Nature Cat, Clifford The Big Red Dog, and Sesame Street educational information and activities to help children learn and grow. 179 packets were English, 18 packets were Spanish.



WEIU-TV is licensed to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University. Our 174-kilowatt digital signal on Channel 51.1 is broadcast from our 502-foot tower located southeast of Humboldt, IL.
